

Rental Guidelines & Regulations

Customer Copy · Ruby Scaffolding · Updated June 2026

Please read these 10 simple points before your scaffolding rental begins — clear, fair, and transparent. This is your customer copy.

01**Measurements are approximate**

Measurements are approximate; the final measurement is taken after completion of the work.

02**Billed by the month**

Rent is calculated monthly — even 10 days is treated as one full month (30 days).

03**One month's rent in advance**

One month's rental amount must be paid in advance before erection begins.

04**Shifting within the same site**

Material shifting within the same site is allowed. Shifting to another site is not allowed and is treated as a new rental.

05**Extra labour for changes**

Extra labour charges apply for shifting or modifications after erection.

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06

Inform additions 3–4 days early

Additional erection must be informed 3–4 days in advance. We are not responsible for work delays caused by the customer.

07

Measured by pipe length

Measurement is calculated on pipe length only; wall measurement is not applicable.

08

Security cheque for materials

Any loss or damage to the material will be charged. A security cheque must be provided for materials at the site.

09

Jally (mesh) costs extra

If jally (mesh/netting) is required, additional rental and fixing/removal charges apply.

10

Pipe & RFT measurement

For pipe scaffolding, measurements are taken as 20 ft, 10 ft, and 6 ft pipe. Lift scaffolding and duct scaffolding are measured in Running Feet (RFT).
